Should you have any safeguarding concerns please contact a member of our children's team.

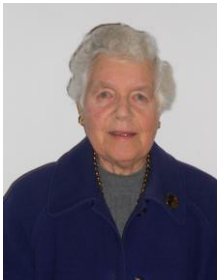

The presence of children in our church is a sign of a healthy parish. St Peter's recognise the important role children have in the future of our Church.

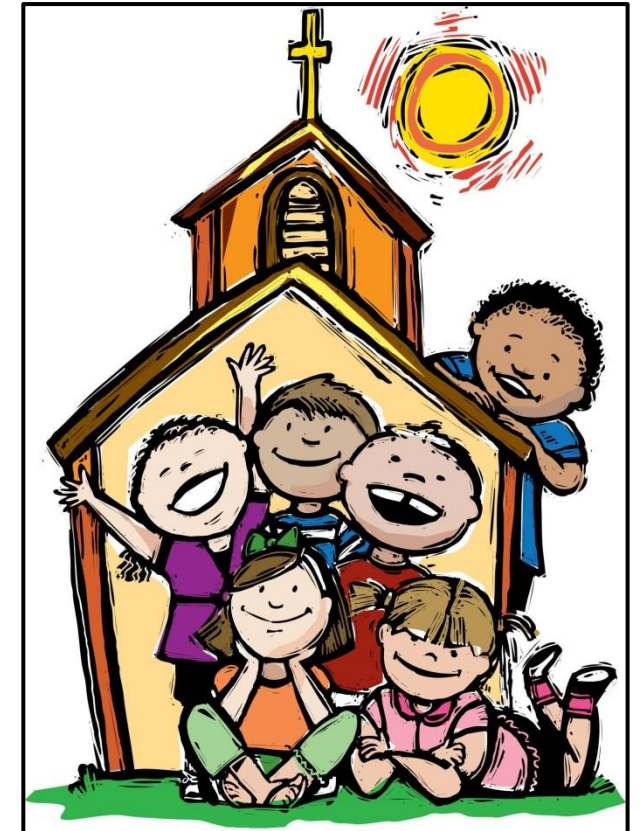
The way in which we welcome children directly affects the way they respond to the Church, God and each other.
