Supporting your child at Church



Please sit wherever you and your child feel comfortable.

Quietly explain the parts of the service and the actions of the Vicar and Congregation.

Sing the hymns, join in prayer and voice the responses. Encourage your children to participate.if possible.

If you have to leave the service with your child for any reason, feel free to do so, but please come back! Toilets are through the door at the back of church, through the link block door and along the coridor to your right.

Please join us for refreshments at the end of the service. Coffee, tea, squash and biscuits are provided and it is a great time to meet new people.

Children's Corner

Located at the back of the church, the children's corner has toys, books and craft activities for younger children.. There is often a member of the children's team on hand and ready to help.
